Lesbian Festival 1992

In keeping with the idea of running an annual Lesbian Festival in Melbourne, a group of dykes coordinated the Lesbian Festival 1992 which was held at various venues around Melbourne, 8 October – 3 November 1992.

The many events on the program included an International Lesbian Day rally and march on 10 October in the City Square, several plays including Undercover by Amazon Theatre and a double bill at the Organ Factory with Voice of the Heart's Read My Lips and Jean Taylor's one-woman play Matri-Spiral Descent; a Trade Fair and Market Day at La Trobe Uni, a Jewish Lesbian Workshop, a Lesbian Swim Night at the Brunswick Baths, a Dogs and Dykes Dine Out Day LesboRaves, exhibitions, spoken word readings, live music and a Matrix Guild Forum, amongst other events and celebrations. The LesFest was attended by many participants from Victoria as well as few from interstate and overseas.

This time the LesFest organisers acted as an umbrella group to coordinate activities and events and to provide publicity rather than try and finance the entire festival so the LesFest did not run at a loss as it had the previous year. However, this was the last of the annual LesFests in Melbourne.
