Sabine Gleditsch (8 February 1955 - 25 November 1997)

Sabine was born in Germany and arrived in Australia in the mid-1980s. She lived in Queensland for awhile before relocating to Melbourne where worked on the German program at SBS Radio for several years.

Sabine attended many lesbian events during her time in Melbourne and enjoyed travelling to various scenic parts of Australia. One of Sabine's essays was included in *Australia for Women: Travel and Culture*, edited by Susan Hawthorne and Renate Klein and published by Spinifex Press.

Sabine joined the Lesbian Cancer Support Group in 1977, attended meetings and designed the logo for the group. She was supported by the members for several months before she died of cancer at home.
