### **Lesbians Unlimited**

Lesbians Unlimited was set up and incorporated towards the end of 1989 in the lead-up to the Lesbian Festival 1990 in Melbourne to provide a legally constituted and incorporated cover for the organisers and related lesbian sub-groups as well as the event itself. Subsequently, LUL went on to provide legal protection for a number of lesbian events and LesFests in Melbourne that eventuated over the following years.

LUL met on a regular monthly basis to discuss business, to consider applications from local lesbian groups for small amounts of funding (with the money left over from the LesFest 1990) and started a campaign to raise money to set up a Lesbian Centre in Victoria. However, with the demise of the Lesbian Space Project in Sydney it was agreed not to continue trying to set up a similar scheme in Victoria.

Over the ensuing years, LUL didn't quite fold but the group did stop meeting on a regular basis and there were several members who continued to maintain the bank account.
