Amazon Theatre

Amazon Theatre began at a meeting on 10 September1989, with the aim of producing lesbian comedies for the lesbian community. The group devised, workshopped and wrote their own scripts and produced their first show, Spot the Dyke, with a cast of characters representing different aspects of the lesbian community including Pat the Lesocrat and Toni the Train Driver. Spot the Dyke was directed by Jackie Smith and performed at The Hive, Footscray Community Arts Centre, on 20/21/22 January during the Lesbian Festival 1990.

Amazon Theatre performed Spot the Dyke at Melbourne Uni on 18 May and again at FCAC for International Lesbian Day, 5 –6 October, 1990, and took Spot the Dyke on tour to Canberra and Sydney, 20 – 21 July 1990.

Encouraged by the enthusiastic reception and with a few more participants Amazon

Theatre again workshopped and wrote another play, Dykes of Our Restless Daze, about the many
and varied housemates and their interactions in a lesbian household, which was directed by

Donna Trevaro and performed in The Pit, FCAC, during the Lesbian Festival, in January, 1991,
and again at the Glasshouse, RMIT, 10 – 11 May 1991.

Amazon Theatre toured Dykes of Our Restless Daze to Adelaide, SA, on 24 – 25 May 1991. And Pat Longmore produced a video of the play which premiered at the Glasshouse Theatre, RMIT in 28 March 1992. The script of Spot the Dyke was launched by Donna Jackson and sold at the same event.

In 1992, Amazon Theatre devised and wrote their third play, Undercover, a lesbian mystery, again with a weird and wonderful cast of characters, which was directed by Susan Paxton and performed at Princes Hill High School, 10/11 and 17/18 July 1992. And again at Princes Hill High, 8 – 10 October, during the Lesbian Festival 1992.

After a break of a year and with only four members left, Amazon Theatre put on their fourth and final play, Della, about breast cancer, its treatment and other related issues. Della was directed by Susan Paxton and performed in the Theatre at FCAC, 21 - 22 October 1994; and again, at Princes Hill High School, 2 – 4 February 1995, during the Midsumma Festival.
