Dwayne Campbell

Dwayne Campbell was an artist who lived in a shared lesbian household in Brunswick East, an inner urban area of Melbourne. In 1994, Dwayne was paid by Amazon Theatre to design an impressive graphic for the first Amazon Theatre teeshirt. Sheril Berkovitch, the co-founder and editor of Lesbiana, screen printed it onto several purple and black teeshirts which were sold to raise funds for Amazon Theatre's fourth production, Della.

Dwayne had a political interest in protesting against the Gulf wars in the early 1990s as evidenced by the teeshirt and the banner she donated to the Archives in 1995, both with the message: Lesbians Say 'No' to the Gulf War, no blood for oil.
