Women's Movement Register

The Women's Movement Register was formed on 3 August 1989 and launched at the Lesbian Conference in Melbourne on 28 January 1990. The aim of the WMR was to set up an herstorical record of feminist activism in the Women's Liberation Movement in Victoria. Feminist activists were asked to document their experiences in the WLM by filling out a questionnaire that covered details about their personal backgrounds, the activist collectives they belonged to, the events they were part of, the paid and unpaid work they did as feminists and any other anecdotal comments they cared to make about their time as feminists.

The WMR collective met regularly for a couple of years or so, some interested feminists did fill out and send in their questionnaires but the collective folded through lack of ongoing interest in the project.
