Victorian Women's Liberation Newsletter #2

The first issue of the newly constituted WL Newsletter collective (the previous collective had folded and the last issue had come out in November 1984) was the IWD edition published in March 1986.

The WLN provided an essential monthly forum for articles, letters, notices of collective meetings, issues for discussion, the dissemination of information about forthcoming events, ads for feminist-run businesses, reviews of books and plays and was an important network for feminists.

The Feminist Flier, a fortnightly double-sided sheet listing forthcoming events, venues, dates and happenings in the community (taking over from WOMB - Women of Melbourne Broadsheet - which had stopped production) was included in the WLM as an insert.

During the almost nine years of its operation many essential issues and campaigns and events were written about and publicised including female genital mutilation, Queen Victoria Hospital Campaign, Pine Gap Women's Peace Camp, Fairlea Women's Prison Action, Sybylla Press, National 10/40 Conference and The Dinner Party.

The WLN continued production till lack of energy and interest caused it to stop with the final issue in November / December 1994. (reference WLN-1 23)
