Glenda Ballantyne (4 July 1955 -)

Glenda Ballantyne attended Templestowe High School before undertaking a Bachelor of Arts in History and Politics at the University of Melbourne. In 2001, she completed a PhD in Sociology at La Trobe University. She was active in the Women's Liberation Club at Melbourne University, 1974 – 1977, and in the Melbourne Women's Liberation Movement operating out of the Women's Centre in the 1970s, where she was involved in a number of specific campaigns as well as being a member of the Publications Committee. She was a contributing editor of the socialist-feminist magazine, *Scarlet Woman*, 1978 –79, and was a founding director of *Sybylla* Co-operative Press and Publications, where she worked in various capacities from 1976 – 1989. She was instrumental in expanding the printing side of *Sybylla* into an innovative and award-winning women's publishing house.
