Labrys

The first issue of Labrys, a monthly lesbian newspaper, was produced by the 13 lesbians who formed the Labrys Collective and published on 5 November 1990, to replace Lesbian News which folded with issue 40, October / November 1990.

Labrys included information about lesbian events such as the Leso Dag Day in country Victoria, articles around a range of issues of concern to lesbians including information about the Lesbian Latex Liberation Front and news about Cross Dressing. Labrys also printed letters to the editor, cartoons, photos, the Separation Street serial as well as listings of regular lesbian venues and community groups.

At the beginning of January 1992, Labrys was owned by BAD Press. The newspaper ran for fifteen issues altogether before it folded in February 1992.

To replace Labrys, the first issue of Lesbiana was published by Pat Longmore and Sheril Berkovitch in March 1992.
